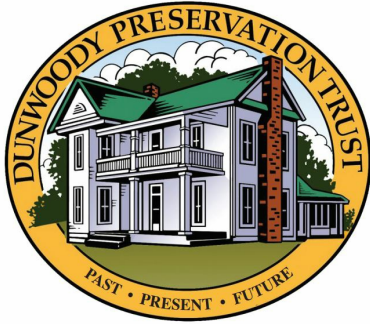

Greetings from Our Executive Director



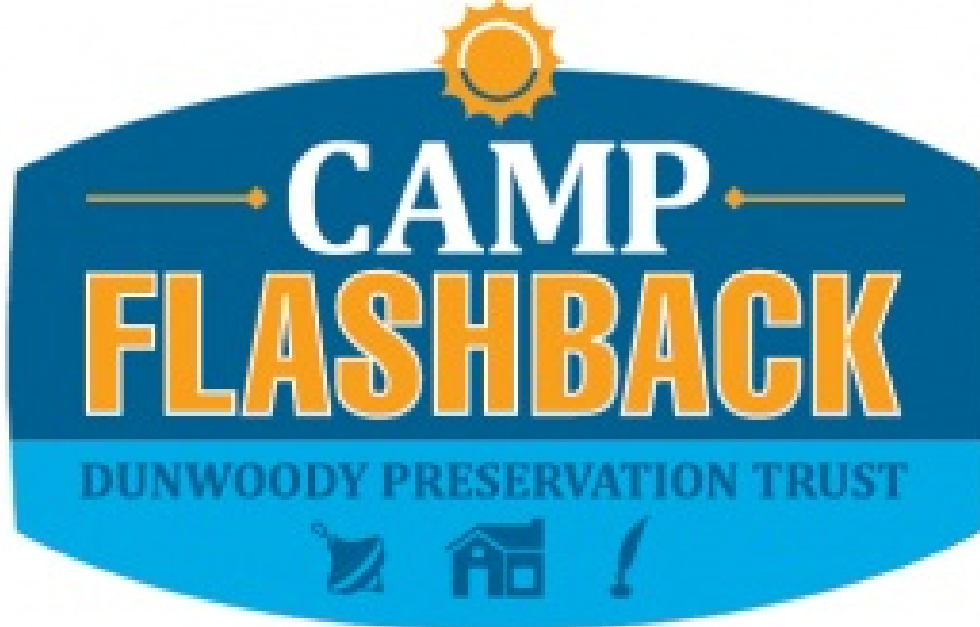

Skip Bell served two tours of duty in Vietnam. The first tour was spent as an Armored Cavalry Platoon Leader, Staff Officer, and Armored Cavalry Troop Commander. The second tour was spent as a helicopter pilot, initially flying the Cobra gunship in an Air Cavalry Troop, then flying the UH-1 "Huey" helicopter in a General Support Aviation Company. Bell describes the differences in the lifestyles of soldiers involved in ground combat missions and those in aviation combat missions.

Carl "Skip" Bell is the president of the Atlanta Vietnam Veterans Business Association (AVVBA). The AVVBA's purpose is to promote patriotism and sponsor activities of a patriotic nature among the business community, to recognize those who served and honor those who gave their lives in the Vietnam War, and to promote the positive image of the Vietnam Veteran, their dependents and the widows and orphans of deceased Vietnam Veterans.
