# Private Events at the Donaldson-Bannister Farm



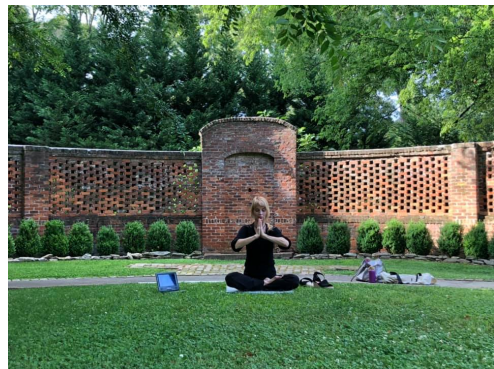

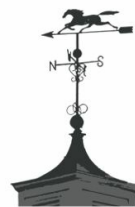
