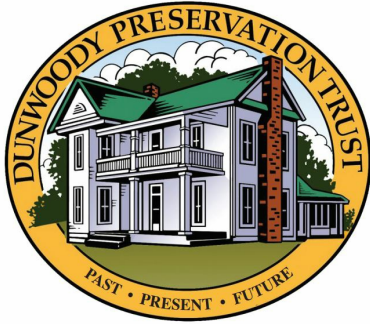

## Volunteering Opportunity New Hope Cemetery Clean Up



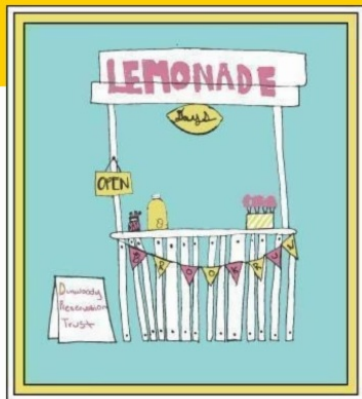
